



Gascoyne River flow advice no.20 2008

Issued by the Department of Water
10 am Thursday 27 March

Rains in the Gascoyne River catchment over the past few days have resulted in several minor flows being recorded at Yinnetharra Crossing, Jimba Jimba and Fishy Pool Gauging Stations. A small flow at Yinnetharra Crossing peaked last night at 1.1m around 9pm. The lead waters of a flow has reached Lyons River Gauging Station this morning at 9.40am and is currently rising.

Gauging Station water levels at 6:00am today were:

Yinnetharra 0.9m and receding;

Lyons River 0.6m; and rising (10am reading)

Jimba Jimba 0.3m and steady;

Fishy Pool 0.2m and steady; and

Nine Mile Bridge 0.4m and slowly receding.

The Department of Water will continue to closely monitor the catchment and river levels and an update will be issued at 10am Friday 28th March.

Gascoyne Irrigators please note that pumping for the month of March is **unrestricted**.
