



Gascoyne River flow advice no.21 2008

Issued by the Department of Water
10 am Friday 28 March

Rains in the Gascoyne River catchment over the past few days have resulted in several minor flows being recorded at Yinnetharra Crossing, Lyons River, Jimba Jimba and Fishy Pool Gauging Stations. The flow peaked last night at Lyons River Gauging station around midnight at 1.5m.

Gauging Station water levels at 6:00am today were:

- Yinnetharra 0.8m and steady;
- Lyons River 1.2m; and falling;
- Jimba Jimba 0.5m and slowly rising;
- Fishy Pool 0.2m and steady; and
- Nine Mile Bridge 0.4m and steady.

The Department of Water will continue to closely monitor the catchment and river levels and an update will be issued at 4pm Friday 28th of March.

Gascoyne Irrigators please note that pumping for the month of March is **unrestricted**.
