



Gascoyne River flow advice no.22 2008

Issued by the Department of Water
4 pm Friday 28 March

Rains in the Gascoyne River catchment over the past few days have resulted in several minor flows being recorded at Yinnetharra Crossing, Lyons River, Jimba Jimba and Fishy Pool Gauging Stations. There have been minor changes in river levels since the previous advice.

Gauging Station water levels at 4:00pm today were:

Yinnetharra 1.0m and slowly rising;

Lyons River 0.6m and falling;

Jimba Jimba 1.5m and slowly rising;

Fishy Pool 0.4m and steady; and

Nine Mile Bridge 0.2m and steady.

At this early stage a small peak is expected at Carnarvon. The height and time of this peak will be estimated once they have registered on the up stream Gauging Stations. The Department of Water will continue to closely monitor the catchment and river levels and an update will be issued at 10am Saturday 29th of March.

Gascoyne Irrigators please note that pumping for the month of March is **unrestricted**.
