



Gascoyne River flow advice N^o 24 2008

Issued by the Department of Water
10 am Sunday 30 March

The Gascoyne River has responded to rain over the past week. After previous peaks, Lyons River and Jimba Jimba are rising again. Fishy Pool initially peaked around 9am yesterday at 1.3m and is currently rising again.

Gauging Station water levels at 9am today were:

- Yinnetharra 1.3m and rising;
- Lyons River 1.6m and rising;
- Jimba Jimba 2.4m and rising;
- Fishy Pool 1.2m and rising; and
- Nine Mile Bridge 0.4m and steady.

A peak of 1.7m is expected at Nine Mile Bridge this afternoon, Sunday, 30th of March. A slightly higher peak is expected to follow, the height and time will be estimated once they have registered on the up stream Gauging Stations. The Department of Water will continue to closely monitor the catchment and river levels and an update will be issued at 4pm Sunday 30th of March.

Gascoyne Irrigators please note that pumping for the month of March is **unrestricted**.
