



Gascoyne River Flow Advice N°32 2008

Issued by the Department of Water
10 am Thursday 3 April

Nine Mile Bridge peaked around 11:30pm last night at 3.0m. Lyons River peaked around 9:30pm last night at 2.3m.

Gauging Station water levels at 9 am today were:

- Yinnetharra 1.2m and falling;
- Lyons River 1.7m and falling;
- Jimba Jimba 2.7m and slowly rising;
- Fishy Pool 2.1m and slowly rising; and
- Nine Mile Bridge 2.7m and falling;

The mid catchment is currently experiencing some rainfall. The Department of Water will continue to closely monitor the catchment and river levels and an update will be issued at 10am Friday 4th of April.

Gascoyne Irrigators please note that pumping for the month of April is **unrestricted**.
