## Gascoyne River flow advice N<sup>o</sup> 35 2008

Issued by the Department of Water  
10 am Sunday 6 April

Due to minor rain in the catchment Yinnetharra had a minor peak around 08:05 am this morning at 1.2 m. Lyons River also had a minor peak around 03:40 am this morning at 1 m.

Gauging station water levels at 9 am today were:

Yinnetharra 1.2 m and steady

Lyons River 0.8 m and falling

Jimba Jimba 2 m and slowly rising

Fishy Pool 1.4 m and steady

Nine Mile Bridge 1.8 m and steady

At this stage a minor follow up peak is expected at Nine Mile Bridge. Height and arrival time will be estimated once they have registered on the up-stream gauging stations. The Department of Water will continue to closely monitor the catchment and river levels and an update will be issued at 10 am Monday 7 April.

Gascoyne irrigators please note that pumping for the month of April is *unrestricted*.
