

# Terms and conditions

1 July 2008 - 30 June 2009

All rebates apply only to domestic projects and do not cover renting, leasing, hiring arrangements or commercial applications.

- 1 To be eligible for a Waterwise rebate, you must complete in full and sign the rebate form and include photocopies of the requested tax invoices. Please do not send original tax invoices and receipts, as we can not guarantee they will be returned.
- 2 Details provided may be used to audit that the products purchased have been installed correctly to guidelines and within the terms and conditions of the Waterwise Rebate Program.
- 3 The rebates offered under the current program are only available for purchases made between 1 July 2008 to 30 June 2009. You have until 30 September 2009 to claim and receive the applicable rebate. For rebatable products purchased on or before 30 June 2008, under the previous rebate program, you have until **30 September 2008** to claim and receive the applicable rebate.
- 4 Elements of the Waterwise Rebate Program are subject to change without notice.
- 5 Rebates are only available to residential properties that are habitable. Only the householder is eligible to apply (companies or businesses are not eligible to apply).
- 6 Rebates are not available for commercial properties or purposes.
- 7 Charitable organisations are eligible for rebates for domestic use; however, not-for-profit organisations such as sporting clubs are not eligible to apply.
- 8 Strata companies, managing agents, builders and developers are not eligible to apply, but may have the rebate deemed to them by the householder.

## Waterwise garden irrigation systems

- 9 A Waterwise rebate of \$300 or 50 per cent of the installation cost (whichever is the lesser amount) is available per residential property for the installation of a new Waterwise irrigation system.
- 10 To be eligible for the rebate, the system must be installed by an endorsed Water Corporation Waterwise garden irrigator. These are listed on the [www.water.wa.gov.au](http://www.water.wa.gov.au) website.
- 11 For the irrigation system to be eligible for a rebate, it must meet the Waterwise irrigator installer standard, which includes: a rain sensor or soil moisture sensor, a controller able to accommodate the state-wide watering day rosters, a scheduling card and strict design and installation criteria.
- 12 The customer may apply for the rebate as soon as the system is installed and is operational.
- 13 To be eligible for a rebate, the customer must attach (to the completed rebate form) a copy of the tax invoice and receipt from the Waterwise garden irrigator. This must detail the system and, where applicable, the controller installed.

1 July 2008 - 30 June 2009

- 14 The new system must be for the whole front yard, whole back yard or both and include lawn and garden beds, but not verges. Rebates will not be paid for parts thereof, or irrigation system maintenance or purchase of new controllers only.
- 15 The applicant must be the owner of the property (tenants must have written approval from the owner to apply).
- 16 Strata companies, managing agents, builders and developers are not eligible to apply, but may have the rebate deemed to them by the householder.
- 17 Only one irrigation system rebate (front, rear or entire garden) to the maximum value of \$300 is available per property.

## Rain sensors

- 18 The Waterwise rebate of \$20 is only available for rain sensors endorsed under the Smart Approved Watermark Scheme. These are listed on the [www.water.wa.gov.au](http://www.water.wa.gov.au) website.
- 19 The rebate is limited to one rain sensor per domestic household.
- 20 The customer may apply for the rebate as soon as the item is purchased.
- 21 To be eligible for a rebate, the customer must attach (to the completed rebate form) a copy of the tax invoice and receipt. This must state the make and model number of the rain sensor.

## Subsurface irrigation systems

- 22 The Waterwise rebate of \$10 is only available for 30 m rolls of subsurface irrigation pipe work endorsed under the Smart Approved Watermark Scheme. These are listed on the [www.water.wa.gov.au](http://www.water.wa.gov.au) website.
- 23 The rebate is limited to 10 rolls of subsurface irrigation pipe work per domestic household.
- 24 The customer may apply for the rebate as soon as the item is purchased.
- 25 To be eligible for a rebate, the customer must provide (on the completed rebate form) the product name and spacing and a copy of the tax invoice and receipt.

## Waterwise garden assessments

- 26 The Waterwise Rebate of \$30 is only available for Waterwise garden assessments performed by endorsed Water Corporation Waterwise garden assessors. These are listed on the [www.water.wa.gov.au](http://www.water.wa.gov.au) website.
- 27 The rebate is limited to one garden assessment per domestic household. The assessment is purely a review of water efficiency within the existing garden. It is not a garden design/redesign service.
- 28 The customer may apply for the rebate as soon as the assessment is conducted.
- 29 To be eligible for a rebate, the customer must attach (to the completed rebate form) a copy of the tax invoice and receipt, a copy of the *Waterwise garden assessment form* and a copy of the *Waterwise garden recommendations form*.

# Terms and conditions

## Swimming pool covers

- 30 The Waterwise rebate of \$200 (capped at 50 per cent of the total cost) is only available for swimming pool covers endorsed under the Smart Approved Watermark Scheme with a minimum warranty of eight years. These are listed on the [www.water.wa.gov.au](http://www.water.wa.gov.au) website.
- 31 The rebate is limited to one pool cover per domestic household.
- 32 The customer may apply for the rebate as soon as the item is purchased.
- 33 To be eligible for a rebate, the customer must attach (to the completed rebate form) a copy of the tax invoice and receipt, stating the make and model number of the pool cover.

## Flow regulators

- 34 The Waterwise rebate of \$2 is only available on flow regulators with a water rating of 3 stars or better. These are listed on the [www.water.wa.gov.au](http://www.water.wa.gov.au) website.
- 35 The rebate is limited to a maximum of \$20 per domestic household.
- 36 To be eligible for a rebate, the customer must attach (to the completed rebate form) a copy of the tax invoice and receipt as proof of installation of an approved flow regulator. The invoice must state the make and model of the regulator installed.

## Greywater re-use systems

- 37 The Waterwise rebate is only available for greywater re-use systems that are approved by the Department of Health. These are listed on the [www.water.wa.gov.au](http://www.water.wa.gov.au) website.
- 38 The rebate is limited to one greywater re-use system per domestic household.
- 39 A Waterwise rebate of up to \$500 applies for greywater re-use systems.
- 40 The rebate is available for both sewerred and non-sewerred residential properties.
- 41 The rebate is available once the greywater re-use system has been installed and a *Permit to use apparatus* has been received from your local council (shire).
- 42 A rebate will only be granted for greywater re-use systems where the effluent is used for irrigation purposes.
- 43 Where required, installation of the greywater re-use system must be undertaken by a licensed plumber in accordance with plumbing by-laws.
- 44 When claiming a rebate, copies of the tax invoices showing the purchase details and plumbing work must be submitted with the completed rebate form.
- 45 Strata companies, managing agents, builders and developers are not eligible to apply, but may have the rebate deemed to them by the householder.

## Washing machines

- 46 Only washing machines with a rating of 4.5 Stars or better are eligible for a Waterwise rebate of \$150.

# Terms and conditions

1 July 2008 - 30 June 2009

- 47 The rebate is limited to one washing machine rebate per domestic household.
- 48 The rebate is available once the washing machine has been fully paid for, installed and is operational.
- 49 A copy of the tax invoice and receipt, stating the make and model number of the washing machine and showing payment in full, is required to receive the rebate.
- 50 Offer not valid for second-hand washing machines, rental agreements or commercial applications.

## Rainwater tanks

- 51 A \$50 rebate applies for purchase and installation of new domestic tanks over 600 litres that are not plumbed in. If the tank is plumbed in for toilet and/or washing machine use at the time of installation and has a capacity of 2000 litres or greater, up to \$600 is available. Plumbing into the house must be undertaken by a licensed plumber, in accordance with plumbing by-laws.
- 52 A copy of the tax invoice for the purchase and (if claiming the plumbed in rebate) a copy of the tax invoice and receipt for plumbing work, must be submitted with the completed rebate form.
- 53 You must check with your local council for approval prior to purchase and installation.
- 54 When installing rainwater tanks, you must ensure you have adequate mosquito controls.
- 55 The rebate is limited to one rainwater tank rebate per domestic household.

## Garden bores

- 56 A Waterwise rebate of \$300 or 50 per cent of the installation cost (whichever is the lesser amount) is available per residential property for the drilling of a new bore, in an area deemed suitable for a bore by the Department of Water.
- 57 If the garden bore is installed by a licensed driller you must submit (with the completed rebate form) the licensed driller's details together with copies of tax invoices and receipts.
- 58 Electrical work for all bores must be in accordance with the *Electricity (Licensing) Regulations 1991*.
- 59 For bores installed by persons other than licensed drillers, copies of tax invoices and receipts for items used in the installation and electrical work must be included with the completed rebate form.
- 60 The rebate is only applicable to successful bores that deliver water.
- 61 Properties sharing a bore must be adjoining to be eligible for the rebate and in an area deemed suitable for a bore by the Department of Water.
- 62 Rebate not valid for bore maintenance, new pumps, reticulation, share bore hook-up to an existing bore, or for bores installed in areas deemed as unsuitable for a bore by the Department of Water.
- 63 Applicant must be the owner of the property (tenants must have written approval from the owner to apply).

- 64 Strata companies, managing agents, builders and developers are not eligible to apply, but may have the rebate deemed to them by the householder.
- 65 To be eligible for a \$300 rebore rebate, the existing bore must be in an area deemed suitable for a bore by the Department of Water and a minimum of \$600 must be spent on redrilling and lining the existing bore to make it operational (does not include pump, electrical or reticulation costs).
- 66 Only one garden bore rebate (new bore, rebore or shared bore) to the maximum value of \$300 available per residential property.
- 67 Strata properties that install a garden bore will receive the applicable rebate (\$300 or 50 per cent of the installation cost, whichever is the lesser) in line with the number of units within the strata plan, i.e. rebate granted is \$300 if there are three strata units = \$100 each.
- 68 Before installing a new bore or refurbishing an old one, find out if your property is in an area identified by the Department of Water as suitable for a bore, by calling the Waterwise helpline on 13 10 39.
